AN ACT

TO DECLARE VACANT THE OFFICES OF THE MEMBERS OF THE PUERTO RICO PLANNING, URBANIZING, AND ZONING BOARD CREATED BY ACT No. 213 OF MAY 12, 1942, AS AMENDED; TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE MEMBERS OF SAID BOARD.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of Puerto Rico:*

Section 1.—Upon the taking effect of this Act, the offices of the members of the Puerto Rico Planning, Urbanizing, and Zoning Board created by Act No. 213 of May 12, 1942, shall be vacant.

Section 2.—The new members shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate of Puerto Rico, as expressed by Act No. 464 of May 14, 1947.

Section 3.—The members appointed pursuant to this Act shall draw the salary and compensation appertaining to said offices until June 30, 1948, in accordance with the Insular Budget for the fiscal year 1947-48; *Provided*, That after June 30, 1948, they shall receive the salary and compensation provided for in the Insular Budget.

Section 4.—This Act, being of an urgent character, shall take effect immediately after its approval.
